Rt. 24S to Exit 12 onto Rt. 140S. Exit 8 Chace Rd. Bear right at stop sign, cross County Rd. go straight onto Mason Rd. end take left onto Rt.18 Camp 1 mile on left.

#### FROM PROVIDENCE -WESTPORT AREAS

Rt. 195 E to Exit 13B onto Rt. 140 N exit 8 Chace Rd. Bear left stop sign cross County Rd. go straight onto Mason Rd. turn left onto Rt. 18 Camp 1 mile on left.

#### FROM CAPE COD-NEW BEDFORD AREAS:

Rt. 195 W Exit 13B onto Rt. 140N Exit 8 Left onto Chace Rd. stop sign cross County Rd. go straight onto Mason Rd. end turn left Rt. 18 Camp 1 mile on left.

#### FROM ROUTE 495 NORTH OR SOUTH

Take Exit 5 to Rt.18S Rt.18 takes a right turn about 5 miles from exit, camp on right on Rt.18 about 9 miles from exit.

#### FROM NEWPORT-FALL RIVER AREAS:

Rt.24N to Exit 12 onto Rt.140 S Exit 8 right onto Chace Rd. stop sign cross County Rd. straight onto Mason Rd. end turn left onto Rt.18 Camp 1 mile left
