In this passage from Ephesians, Paul is praying to the Christians in Ephesus, that they will have the power to *grasp* how immense is the love of Christ. In the Amplified version, *grasp* is expanded to mean, "*experience* for ourselves." When I read this passage in a daily devotion, I couldn't help thinking, isn't this what happens on a Tres Dias weekend? We *experience* God's love in a mighty way, through the community of believers!

In the song <u>Holy Ground</u>, the second verse goes like this. "These are holy hands, He's given me holy hands, He works through these hands, and so these hands are Holy." While not a quote from scripture, this verse reflects accurately how God works in His kingdom – through His people, and very often with miraculous result.

On the upcoming Men's and Women's Weekend this Fall (Sep. 18-21 & Nov. 13-16 respectively) the RIMA community has even more opportunities to flood the candidates with His love than on prior recent weekends. 
