Steve Higgins opened the meeting with devotions and prayer.

The report of the Recording Secretary was accepted as presented.

The Treasurer reported a balance of \$6487.88 in the savings account and \$508.00 in the checking account. A motion was made and seconded to accept the Treasurer's report. Passed.

Judy Borman made a motion to keep the same slate of officers, President – Steve Higgins; Vice President – Eric Borman; Recording Secretary – Betty Bailey; Corresponding Secretary – Judy Borman; Treasurer – Jeanne Amaral; for the coming year. The motion was seconded, the Recording Secretary was ordered to cast one ballot for those nominated. The motion passed.

Steve reported that the pasta and praise was a success with about 30 people enjoying the food and music. The 'Love Bucket' donations at pasta and praise amounted to \$62.00

An invoice has been received from the convent Immaculate Conception Convent in Putnam for a 10% deposit on the weekends we will be having there until May, 2013. Since we still have a deposit at Cathedral Camp, Jeanne Amaral will contact the camp and request its return. A Motion was made, seconded and passed to that effect. The schedule for the upcoming weekend leadership meeting at Immaculate Conception Convent was discussed. Steve Higgins reported that he has electronic copies of everything needed – how to do a Tres Dias weekend and all the tools that are needed. The men's box, which had been missing, has been found. Steve also has the combined men's and women's spiritual directors file. On the upcoming weekend Steve would like to give everyone who wants one a copy on thumbdrive. It is all the how-to tools,\. Cost is \$5.00.

To be discussed on Saturday will be team meetings, committing to the team as well as the external team and the dynamics of same. Also the dynamics of the weekend and why. How to properly pack up after a weekend, and

# **COMMUNITY CORNER**

At the Tres Dias Spring Training Weekend, the question "Why are you here," was posed again. This was my why.

First of all, I am in NO way a public speaker! I also do not like confrontation. If you pose a question, I can give you an answer, but I'd much rather think about it for a while, so I don't forget or leave out anything important. So when the question was posed, "Why are you here," I couldn't give an immediate, well-thought out answer. In listening to the answers people gave, I had a connection with most of the other people's reasons. It changed me, I was like Nancy, so quiet I wouldn't say a word, let alone stand up and give a rollo. God doesn't call the equipped, He equips those that He calls. Rose said the word Broken, and I thought to myself, "Yup, that's why I'm here." I'm broken, I'm hurting, I feel alone and I am lost-- Which brings me to my Reunion Group. I wouldn't be here without these ladies—many of whom are here this weekend. They can just look at me and know that things are not Okay. They pray for me when I'm too depressed to get out of bed to attend Reunion Group or church. They lay hands on and pray over me when things are tough. They call me up to check on me when they haven't seen or heard from me in a while. I get regular emails from a couple of them on a regular basis to just check in. It's not

only my Reunion group, but other brothers and sisters in Christ. Bryan will send me a text every now and then, Rose will write on my Facebook wall.

And because I am broken, I serve on weekends, not only because I'm called, but because I get so much by serving the new candidates with other Pescadores. I think the biggest reason why I am here is the <u>love</u> I feel when I am with other Tres Dias brothers and sisters. It still amazes me the amount of love shining out of each one of you. 1 Corinthians 13:4-13 says:

<sup>4</sup>Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. <sup>5</sup> It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs. <sup>6</sup> Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. <sup>7</sup> It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres.

<sup>8</sup>Love never fails. But where there are prophecies, they will cease; where there are tongues, they will be stilled; where there is knowledge, it will pass away. <sup>9</sup>For we know in part and we prophesy in part,<sup>10</sup> but when completeness comes, what is in part disappears. <sup>11</sup> When I was a child, I talked like a child, I thought like a child, I reasoned like a child. When I became a man, I put the ways of childhood behind me. <sup>12</sup> For now we see only a reflection as in a mirror; then we shall see face to face. Now I know in part; then I shall know fully, even as I am fully known.

<sup>13</sup> And now these three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.
