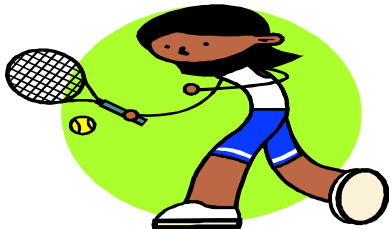


A basketball in my hands is worth about \$19.

It depends on whose hands it's in.**



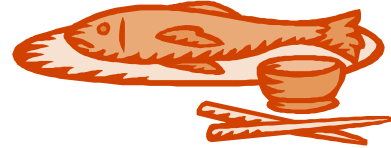
**A tennis racket is useless in my hands.

It depends whose hands it's in.**



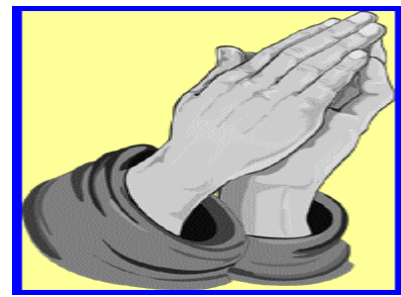
**A slingshot in my hands is a kid's toy.
