Opening prayer and Scripture were given by Ann Marie DeMerchant.

RECORDING SECRETARY: The minutes of the January meeting were accepted as presented.

TREASURER: The Treasurer's Report was accepted as presented. Paul passed our copy of an appeal from Fairfield County Tres Dias which resulted in \$21,000 being added to their treasury. Using this kind of an appeal was discussed.

Gary O'Keefe and Greg Crème have offered to help create a new website design which would be more easier for pescadores to access - cost is approximately \$200 per year for our own domain. After discussion the motion was made, seconded and passed to go ahead with the plan.

It was suggested that, in the future, the sponsor of each new prescadore be recorded in the box containing all names.

There was discussion of the advantages of the Secretariat being incorporated. Cost is approximately \$130. which would allow us to accept charitable contributions. Paul Chaltas and Ann Marie DeMerchant will check out various aspects of incorporation.

RECTOR ADVISOR: Both rectors have their rector advisors, Barbara has her SDs but needs to complete

her team, Dan needs an SD and his team is coming along fine.

VICE PRESIDENT: Eric is very pleased regarding the new website.
