THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF TRES DIAS AND YOUR PART IN IT.

THE PURPOSE OF TRES DIAS. To spread the Good News of Christ by encouraging the living of the Christian fundamental, this is first to love God; then to love all people.

STAGES OF TRES DIAS.

- 1. Pre-Tres Dias- Identifying candidates with qualities of leadership, encouraging them to make Tres Dias, and sponsoring them.
- 2. The Tres Dias Weekend Preparation for the Fourth Day.
- 3. The Fourth Day The objective of Stages 1 and 2; actually living the Christian fundamental and persevering as an apostle of Christ.

Your Role in Stage 1:

Stage 1 can be described by one word: SPONSORSHIP. Sponsorship is not just signing an application form on the line headed "Sponsor's Signature"; it is much more! Sponsorship begins when we identify a likely candidate for Tres Dias. Your job as a sponsor is to befriend this person, encourage him to make Tres Dias, and to provide any assistance the candidate or his family may require, so that he can make the weekend. Sponsorship continues well into the Fourth Day.

Your Role in Stage 2:

Stage 2 is the most remarkable of the three stages, but it is not an end in itself. You might be called upon to play any of several roles at this stage; all are very important because Tres Dias won't work without all of them. Of these roles however, *the most important role you can play is to offer palanca*. Palanca is the fuel that makes Tres Dias go.

Your Role in Stage 3:

The blessing you have received through Tres Dias must be passed on! Each one of us has been called to be Christ's apostle, and that was no accident!

Sponsorship:

Who should make a Tres Dias weekend? The ideal candidate is a mature, wellinformed Christian, possibly already a leader in his church, with a stable home environment and a reasonably open mind. Not all 'good' candidates are ideal candidates; so a sponsor must exercise judgment. The major criterion which must not be violated is that the candidate and his family must be able to accept and handle the weekend, with all its emotional elements. Tres Dias is NOT a marriage clinic, nor group therapy, nor is it meant to be a tool of conversion to Christianity.

How well should you know your candidate? As a rule of thumb, know him well enough to be able to fill out his application form from your personal knowledge of him.



RIMA TRES DIAS SECRETARIAT MEETING

TRES DIAS SECRETARIAT MEETING JUNE 2, 2012 PRESENT: Steve Higgins, Andrea Higgins, Sue Landry, Roland Boucher, Christina Bourquin, Gil Bourquin, Brenda Higgins, Kathy Bracken, Margaret Payne, Vicky Shears, Becky Shears, Eric Borman, Judy Borman, Lee Gardner, Diane Fleweling, Caroline Newcombe, Betty Bailey.

YOUR ROLE IN TRES DIAS: Being on a team – Commitment. Steve talked of his experiences in Tres Dias being on a team. First, there is commitment. Having been to 10 or more leadership meetings encouraged him as he found the joy of working through any issues that came up.

The minutes of the May Tres Das Secretariat were approved as presented.

There was no Treasurer's report.

Discussion as to the advantages of holding our Spring and Fall weekends at Immaculate Conception in Putnam followed. On a motiom by Andrea Higgins, seconded by Kathy Bracken, the motion passed. One of the reasons tp move to Immaculate Conception is that the cost is half the cost of Cathedral Camp. 2012 and 2013 costs will be: Double occupancy -\$100.00, Single occupancy -\$150.00 in 2012. Double occupancy \$150.00, single occupancy \$200.00 in 2013.On a motion by Eric Borman, seconded by Brenda Higgins, the motion passed. Team members will be advised of the price of the weekend at the time they are asked to serve. Blackstone Church has offered, as part of their Missions giving, to pay for 1 man and 1 woman to go to Tres Dias weekend. Can be either a team member or candidate.

BASIC REPORT FROM THE SPRING LEADERSHIP MEETING; 1) Help is needed – There is a need to get a Communications Committee active. RIMA RING should be for prayer only. 2) Face Book page – For informational purposes only. 3) Butterfly – Needs help from people to submit items for community information to keep Tres Dias informed. 4) Website – Be sure to send Gary O'Keefe information.

The Communication Committee needs one person to keep in touch with the above 4 and be certain he or she bets the information to each.

It is felt there is no need for both a pre and post weekend committee – only an External team who need to be guided by the Weekend Committee person in getting information to the above committees. It is also his/her job to ask people for help in opening and closing the weekends. There is a need to simplify the by-laws. Only need these 2 committees (weekend and communications) to work with the Community Coordinator. We also need to develop leaders to being them to the next level. There is a need to find out who is interested in future in developing to the next level. The question is how do we do outreach and which churches used to send candidates for the weekends. Also, after the weekend there is a definite need for 4th Days events to get the new Pescadores interested and active.

Everyone needs to go school at the first team meeting. This is a necessity to prepare for weekend. On a motion by Kathy Bracken, seconded by Eric Borman the motions to form a Communications Committee passed. The Communication Committees responsibility is to get information out to the community. Chair of this committee is Caroline newcombe

Eric Borman informed us that for \$129.00 we can get the International data base, although he said there is a free one at "Star Office". The International assessment is the same as last year. Judy and Eric are going to Korea in June for international.

The Weekend Committee consists of Winnie Loan, Roland Boucher, Julie White. Kathy Bracken offered her help.

Men's Fall Weekend Rector for 2012 is Roland Boucher, for Spring 2013 rector it is Steve Higgins. Julie White is the Fall 2012 Fall Weekend rector. If anyone is interested in serving, please contact Roland or Julie. Both need co-rectors. It is not automatic that you go ahead as there are certain criteria and some cannot commit to long range plans. Qualified people are needed to be in position to assume the next slot.

Roland plans to have a family get together sometime in June after the school. It was suggested that he have team meeting dates so the team knows when the dates are in advance. His first team meeting is planned for July 1st at 2 p.m. at 273 Great Road, Smithfield, RI Prayer Partners: There is a need to establish prayer partners – there is no need for prayer partners to be on sight – they can be either in the rollo room at the time one is giving their rollo or not.

The following technical amendments were all unanimously approved by ballot by RIMA Tres Dias:1) Rules for nomination at International Secretariat; 2)Based on Cursillo, approved the changes in technical problems; 3)Must be eligible to hold office and abide by the by-laws of Tres Dias; 4)There will be a special assembly on July 1, 2012 and January 30, 2013 to approved the budget and community assessments.Election of officers on September 15, 2012 in Korea;5) Re: budget Assessment will be \$56.—per unit for 2012; 6; Proxy ballot – Eric Borman will cast one ballot; Eric Borman is up for reelection -14 are running of which 11 will be selected.

The sponsor should know the candidate well enough to be able to discuss the price of the room with the candidate. If more help is needed 9the candidate should contact the Secretariat through the sponsor.

Roland Boucher informed the Secretariat that John Polte has offered to play at Great Family Worship Center at 7 pm on September 1st. A free will offering will be taken to help pay for candidates needing assistance. Address is 175 Eddy Dowling Highway, Smithfield, RI.

Pre-weekend applications should be sent to Helen Harvey at 134 New Road, Thompson, CT 06277. Helen will receive the checks and forward them to Jeanne Amaral. IMPORTANT: The Rector or Chief are responsible for the application money to be sent to Helen by 2 weeks prior to the weekend. This gives Helen an opportunity to do her job.

Rev. Ruth Blais reminded those present that candidates names need to be known to the Secretariat, otherwise they cannot be prayed for or receive palanca. Donations may be sent to Jeanne Amaral.

Supplies for the weekends are available at Staples – this being the start of the school year, they are all on sale.

TRAILER: Winnie Loan must get the trailer out of her yard - the ultimate goal is to have it stored in the Putnam, Ct. area. Pescadores are asked to get the word out in the Connecticut area to see if anyone there can store it for us. The trailer is insured and the question was asked if we should get the contents insured. After discussion it was agreed that we do not have to insure the contents.

The Women's weekend team has been formed. Their first meeting is August 18th. It is reported that it is a wonderful team with 23 women. Julie White is Rector and Nancy Cargene is Chief. The office of co-rector has been left open. Community coordinator is Jean Boucher. Tres Dias School is AUGUST 18TH, 9 AM-2 PM.

Andrea Higgins is going to contact the convent to see if they can use the convent chapel.

The Rector of the Men's team reported that they had no needs right now. At the present time, they have 1 confirmed candidate.
